Her thesis, Participatory-budgeting model for effective financial management in Midvaal and Lesedi Local Municipality, addresses the challenges in municipal budget formulation, highlighting the need for increased citizen participation. Mhlanga’s proposed model aims to enhance municipal budgeting processes not only in South Africa but globally, ensuring better responsiveness to local needs and more effective financial management.
